

Davis Chamber Travel Switzerland FAQs

- **What is Chamber Travel?**- The Davis Chamber has partnered with Citslinc International, a travel agency, to organize group trips. You have the opportunity to travel at a group rate, appreciate the ease of having your trip planned for you, and enjoy the company of other community members! This is also a prime opportunity to build better business relationships and friendships!
- **Do you have to be a chamber member to join this trip?**- No, anyone is welcome to join!
- **When is the last day to register?**- The deadline for registering and paying the total cost of the trip is June 15, 2026. We have had a lot of interest in this trip, so the sooner you register and secure a spot, the better!
- **How do I register?**- To register, please fill out the form at <https://davischamberofcommerce.com/chamber-travel-switzerland-trip/>. Once you complete the registration form, Davis Chamber will reach out with the deposit invoice of \$400. Once this deposit is paid, your spot is secured! Please also send a copy of your passport to mandy@davischamberofcommerce.com so the travel agency can book your flights.
- **What does the cost of the trip include?**- It includes airfare, hotel accommodations, tour guides and tour bus fees, any entrance fees, and three meals each day.
- **What if I want to book my own flights?**- If you prefer to book your own flight (whether you plan to extend your trip, upgrade to business class, or ensure you can choose your own seat, etc.), you have the option to do so. Citslinc will deduct \$500 off your total tour fare should you choose to purchase your own airfare. You are responsible for any added costs until you meet up with the group.
- **Can I join the tour late or leave early?**- Yes, with the understanding that you are responsible for any travel expenses outside what the tour provides.
- **What is the cancellation policy?**- If you need to cancel the trip for any reason after June 15th, \$2,000 plus the \$400 registration fee will not be refundable. The remaining cost of the trip will be refunded to you.
- **Do I need a passport, and when do I need it by?**- Yes, you will need a passport no later than June 15th. If you don't have one yet, plan at least two months to receive it. You may consider expediting it if needed. Passports need to be valid for at least six months past the travel date.
- **I don't want to share a room with anyone. Can I get my own individual room?**- Yes, you can. There is an added fee for single travelers of \$1200.
- **What are the luggage limits on the airplane and buses?**- Refer to the airline's policy for luggage limits. We suggest avoiding checked luggage, but you can if you'd like. You will be responsible for the cost. The buses have sufficient storage, but we still encourage you to pack lightly.
- **Do I need to be physically active to participate in these trips?**- We want you to be comfortable and to enjoy your trip! We suggest that you be somewhat physically active if you plan to attend. All of our trips require walking some distances, occasionally uphill. Also, not all sites we visit are as accessible to wheelchairs, walkers, etc. If you aren't sure, reach out and we can give you more details.
- **Can I choose my seats on the flight?**- It depends. Group travel is purchased differently. Sometimes the airlines will allow you to choose your seat, sometimes they won't. If it is important to you to get a certain seat, we suggest you purchasing your own flight.
- **Will there be accommodations for dietary needs?**- Citslinc will do what they can to accommodate dietary needs. Please indicate your needs on your registration form. It is also helpful to let your tour guide know when you arrive in Switzerland.
- **I've registered! Now what?** - We're so excited to have you join us! Once you've paid your \$400 deposit, Citslinc will work on booking your flights, hotels, etc. You will hear more detailed information as we get closer to travel.
